
Learning/teaching/training activities

C4: The main aim of the LTTA in Budapest was to enable students to visit a Science Center where they could get to know more about science (physics, chemistry) while they were playing games, entertaining.

All the five days were divided into two parts, activities at the school in the morning and cultural visits in the afternoon.

Each day they attended the school where they worked in international groups which improved their team working abilities, creativity and foreign language skills.

Each day they had a cultural visit in the capital of Hungary where the Hungarian students were the tour guides. These cultural visits tried to show the most famous landmarks of Budapest.



7th April 2019 - Sunday - Day 0

Some groups arrived that day, others had some cultural visit at a museum called "The House of Terror" and a concert in the Matthias Church.

8th April 2019 – Monday – Day 1

The students had a tour in our school then they explored the school by themselves in international groups. They played photo scravenger hunt game.

They had some warm-up games in order to get to know each other better and then the Hungarian students introduced some games to the other countries.

Csopa is the first science center, interactive scientific playing area and entertainment center in Hungary and Central and Eastern Europe, which completes gradual education of natural sciences and teaches all age groups in an informal and experience-based way.


All the topics and thematics, the tools and games in the 5000-sq metre-playing area, the lectures and experimental demonstrations in the Öveges Auditorium and the unique programmes of Csopa are related to sciences – particularly natural sciences – and are professionally reliable. Although it is not a school, scientific education is their priority: their mission is to make children interested in learning natural sciences through an experimental way and to make studying a fun.

In the afternoon we visited Várkert Bazár, the Buda Castle, Matthias Church and the Fisherman's Bastion.



10th April 2019 - Wednesday - Day 3

In the morning the students prepared a game dictionary in international groups. The Greek team prepared the chart at home and students in international teams had to write the meaning in their national language. They also added some other words. They worked online in a Google Sheet. The students were really active and enjoyed working together.

In the afternoon the whole group visited the Market Hall, National Academy and the Parliament.



11th April 2019 – Thursday – Day 4

In the morning the students could observe lessons in the school. They could choose which lesson to visit, Hungarian, Economics, Tourism, English. As they reported they really liked the lessons, for some they were different, for some weren't that they got used to in their own schools.

After the lesson visits they prepared a game in international groups. They worked in group of fours and by the end of the morning they produced 4 board games. They got cardboards, markers, scissors, glue. They used their imagination and creativeness and the products were amazing.



While the students were making the boardgames, the coordinators of the project were having a meeting.

In the evening we had a dinner together in a restaurant where the students and teachers had great time. They chatted, played games and enjoyed each other's company.



12th April 2019 – Friday – Day 5

In the morning the whole group played a Kahoot game which based on videos of every participating country. The Greek team made a clip of them and prepared the questionairre.

Also the Turkish team prepared a game at home for this meeting. They made a puzzle from the previous meetings' pictures and wrote some questions. If the team (again international) answered for the question right, they got a piece of the puzzle.









In the afternoon the group walked up to the Gellért Hill and had a panoramic view of Budapest.



All the countries agreed that this LTTA meeting was very productive. The 25 students who took part in enjoyed themselves really well and they could work in international groups, they got to know about each other's countries, cultures, they communicated in English and became friends.
